Job Summary

The candidate's primary responsibility is to work with the OWLS Program Manager to create and execute the curriculum for the Outreach, Lacrosse and Academy lacrosse based programs.

- Coach Outreach clinics at OWLS schools and community partner organizations
- Lead coach in coordination with volunteer coaches at our weekly League practice and games
- Head coach of the Academy Boys Club Lacrosse team providing enhanced lacrosse coaching to the Academy Scholars on Saturdays and additional games/tournaments
- Collaborate with the OWLS Girls Coach throughout girls' lacrosse season
- Refresh OWLS lacrosse skill and player development curriculum
- Organize and inventory equipment / apparel for students and partners
- Work with fitness partner to integrate into lacrosse program
- Report to Program Manager regarding all program updates and execution of lacrosse programs
- Collect attendance and data when Program Manager is not onsite
